Tip(s) of the Month: Both courtesy of R. Antonelli.

- 1) Cone shaped air fresheners (such as Renuzit) make great storage for small yarn balls, ravel cord or even a fine tool holder.
- 2) 2nd tip of importance for "hands on projects": If knitting a sock with cotton spandex fiber add serger thread to the body of the sock, it will extend the life and durability of your knitting.
