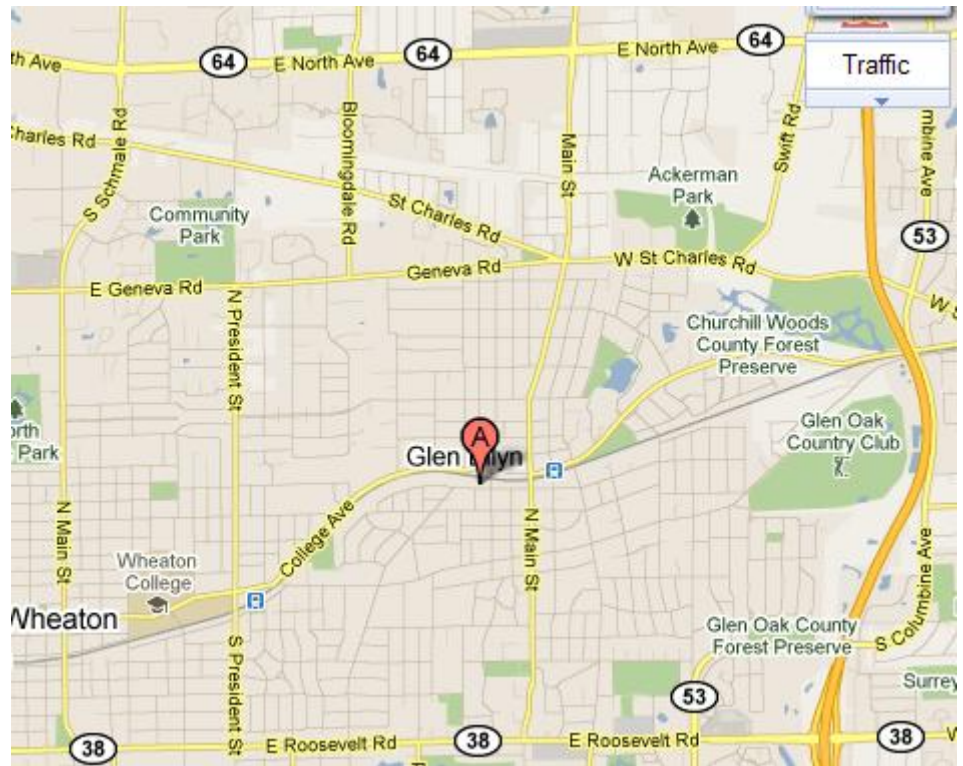
Great Beginnings: Back to Basics
